break er 1 ?bre? k?r n 1 a person or thing that breaks 2 a wave that breaks or dashes into foam 3 a person indicating a wish to transmit a message on a cb radio esp on a channel already in use 4 brake 1 def 4 5 an implement used for breaking up rocks soil lumps of coal or ore etc 6 circuit breaker 1125 75 break er 2 noun a person or thing that breaks something such as a person or firm that breaks up old cars etc a large wave with a white crest on the open sea or one that breaks into foam on the shore j d chuck norris a trucker from california returns from the road to learn that an old friend was assaulted and paralyzed by sergeant strode don gentry a policeman in texas city california he makes inquiries into texas city and learns that its policemen strode and deputy boles ron cedillos have a history of trapping truckers for a corrupt judge named trimmings 1 a one that breaks b a machine or plant for breaking rocks or coal c chiefly british one who breaks up ships or cars for salvage d a device for opening a circuit specifically circuit a circuit breaker is an electrical safety device designed to protect an electrical circuit from damage caused by an overcurrent or short circuit its basic function is to interrupt current flow to protect equipment and to prevent the risk of fire electrical circuit breakers help to keep your home safe from electrical fires by stopping the flow of electricity should something go wrong sometimes using several appliances on the same electrical circuit at the same time can trip the circuit breaker if this happens regularly contact an electrician the breaker may need to be replaced you may need to put the appliances on a sometimes called arc fault circuit breakers afcis detect unexpected electrical discharges or arcs that could cause fires for damp or wet locations such as kitchens baths and outdoor locations you ll need ground fault circuit interrupters gfcis nov 26 2019 anytime you install a large electrical appliance whether it s 120 or 240 volts install it on its own dedicated circuit with the correct size wire and circuit breaker as you can see from fig e a 20 amp breaker with thicker no 12 wire can carry more current than a 15 amp circuit with no 14 wire when you re wiring or rewiring a kitchen laundry room bathroom aug 12 2022 a breaker box flips a switch to disconnect the current if it detects a surge once you flip the switch back on it reestablishes the connection a fuse box houses fuses that each contain a small wire that melts when it gets too hot disconnecting the electrical current once a fuse has blown it s no longer functional the circuit breaker is an essential safety device in your home it is a switch that monitors the electrical current and automatically interrupts electrical flow in a circuit in case of an overload or short circuit breakers are built to last decades but if there are burn marks around the circuit breaker or it emits a burning smell it is time to replace it
